- Introduction to Electronic Warfare (EW), Human Intelligence (HUMINT), Signals Intelligence (SIGINT), Psychological Operations (PSYOP), Cyber
- Identifying capabilities gaps
- Introduction to the inter-agency
- Concept of Operations (CONOP) Development
- Execution development
- The approval process
- Post execution activities
- Develop and monitor Measures of Effectiveness (MOE) / Measures of Performance (MOP)
- Working with coalition / partner forces

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Emphasis is on U.S. Joint doctrine, tactics, techniques, and procedures (TTP) to prepare Military, Civilians and select Contractors to participate in Sensitive Activities integration, coordination, planning and execution at the tactical and operational levels in a variety of Joint organizations
